## How to build solidarity and resistance

Survivors and relatives of victims of racist/fascist violence and civil initiatives come together to talk about how to build solidarity and resistance with an international and intercommunal perspective. Racist assassinations and attacks have been planned systematically, long before the NSU complex and not just in Germany. State-sponsored racism, discrimination, oppression and assassinations have a long tradition in European nations and societies. Racist structures of power and domination are reproduced and legitimated by Eurocentrism and colonial attitudes which permeate society and government institutions. Murderous effects on “strangers”, Blacks, people of color, migrants, Romani people, religious minorities and asylum seekers are the result everywhere.

We want to talk about these facts and public reactions in an open conversation with survivors and initiatives. Issues include solidarity, self-organization and resistance, respectful commemoration and concrete compensation demands by survivors and relatives of victims, as well as the consequences of the NSU trial.
